Dear parents

We are rushing towards the end of term and the end of the academic year. The final two weeks are always pretty hectic and this year is no exception. Next week we are looking forward to the Year 6 production of 'Roald Dahl's Goldilocks and the 3 Bears'. The children and the staff have been working really hard on this since before half term. We do have some spare tickets for the afternoon performance on Tuesday at 2pm; contact the office if you'd like a ticket. At the end of the week we will be sending home the children's end of year school reports along with any results of the Statutory assessments - Year 6 SATs, Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check, Year 2 SATs and Year 1 Phonics Screening. In years 1, 3, 4 and 5 the report will include the results of the latest NFER tests. At times, the results of the tests do not match the Teacher Assessment. Some children love a test and do really well, other children really struggle with them, impacting on their scores either way. Teacher Assessments are made after the teacher has reviewed the work produced over time independently in class. All the assessment data will be passed on and discussed between teachers and teaching assistants as part of the transition process.
