Dear Parents,

At Dilton Marsh Primary School we take Attendance very seriously, we realise that to learn, develop and fulfil their true potential, every child needs to be in school every day in able to access the school curriculum to its fullest.

We work very closely with the children to ensure that we can meet their needs, to provide an engaging and enriching curriculum and to support them if they have any worries or concerns, thus ensuring that their experience of school is as rewarding and happy as possible.

We hope that you will support us in ensuring that your child is in school every day, on time and ready to engage with the day's learning.

To reward the children's good attendance, we have developed a new system of whole school awards linked to recognising 100% attendance throughout the year.

The first award will be given out next week to celebrate those children who had 100% attendance within the first term.

The Reward System is as follows-

One term's 100% attendance.	Certificate 100% badge Name on the class Excellent Attendance Club poster.
Three term's 98% plus attendance	Certificate Pen or Pencil Name on the class Excellent Attendance Club poster in silver.
Five term's 98% plus attendance	Certificate Attendance wristband Name on the class Excellent Attendance Club poster in gold.
At the end of the school year there will be a treat for every child in school who has an attendance of 98% or higher for the whole year.	The treat will be decided upon nearer the time but could include film and popcorn, picnic and games. School Council will be invited to consider what would make a suitable treat.
100% attendance for the whole year.	Certificate £5-00 voucher to be given out at the end of the school year in July.

We do realise that children can become ill during the school year and although we do encourage children to be in school every day, we realise that sometimes children are too unwell to be in school. The reward system recognises this as it gives children who may have already had absence from school a chance to complete terms to gain at least 4 of the awards. Our aim is that the children will be happy to come to school every day and will be keen to engage with our attendance awards.


