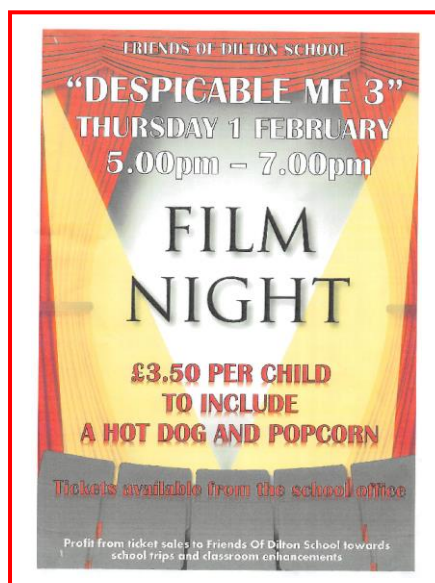

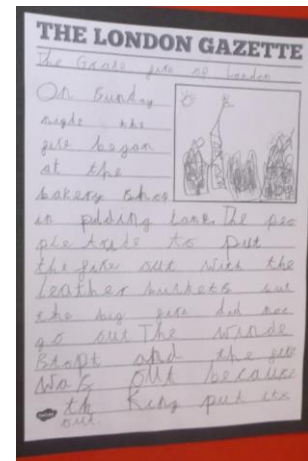

Chestnut Class have created some amazing 'Dragon Eye' art



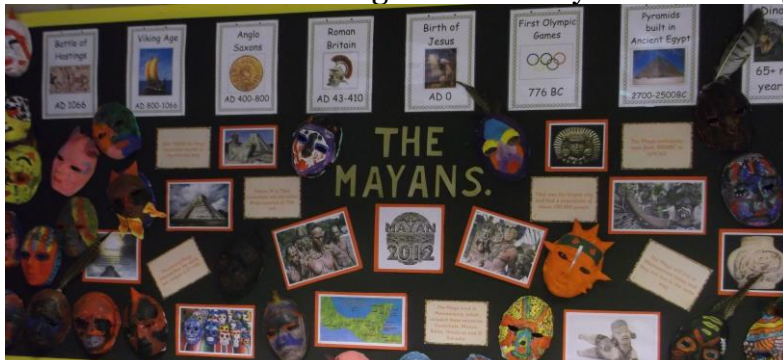
Willow Class have made a super Viking Long Ship and the children have designed their own shields
