This week's Spotlight - What is a Showcase?

Next week Chestnut Class, Lime Class and Cherry Class are holding our first Showcase sessions with the other classes in the following weeks. We have planned the Showcases for the children to share their learning from the term. Each class will start with a whole class presentation which will be similar to a Sharing Assembly. This may include singing, dancing, sharing their writing or other work. It is really important that parents are here for 2.30pm so that they can see this section and the children are not distracted by your arrival. After this there will be chance for you to look through the work with your child. If you are not able to attend your child will share their work with an adult.

Shortly before the end of the school day the teacher will ask you to leave the classroom so that they can get the class ready for the end of the day. They will then discharge the children as normal.

Music Mark


In recognition for our commitment to music education we have been awarded the Music Mark again this year - well done to Mrs Lawrence for securing this for us.
