How to get started

- 1. Go to https://dilton-marsh-cofe-primary-school.uk.arbor.sc/
- 2. On the Log In screen, select 'First time logging in?'
- 3. Follow the instructions to set up your password, by using the email address the school has on record for you as a parent/guardian. Please check if you are unsure.
- 4. To download the Arbor App go to the App Store or Google Play Store on your phone and search 'Arbor'
- 5. Click 'Install' on Android or 'Get' on iPhone then open the App 5. Enter your email, select the school, then enter your password.
- 6. Accept the Terms & Conditions and enter one of your child's birthday.
