Dear parents

This coming week as a school we are celebrating the Harvest Festival. This will include class worship and whole school worship where we will give thanks to God for the bountiful Harvest we can see around us this year. On Tuesday, Reverend Caroline will come into school to lead our Harvest Festival service. This year we will worship in school. Wessex Water

We have been notified by Wessex Water that they will be carrying out maintenance along the High Street starting on Monday 16th October 2023 for an estimated two weeks. They will be installing 4-way traffic lights along the High Street including on the mini roundabouts at St Marys Lane and The Hollow.

This will inevitably cause congestion and delays during busy periods, particularly at the start and end of the school day. Parking will also be extremely limited.

Reminder flu vaccinations - Monday 16th October 2023

As you may have seen in the media this week, the NHS are prioritising vaccinations for school aged children to prevent them from getting seriously ill from flu this winter and to help break the chain of transmission of the virus to the wider population and those who are vulnerable to being hospitalised.

Currently we have 113 / 175 children who are signed up to receive the vaccine here in school before half term. It would be really positive to get those remaining 62 children included.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, the type of flu can vary each winter, so it is recommended to have it again this year or they won't be fully protected from different strains.
